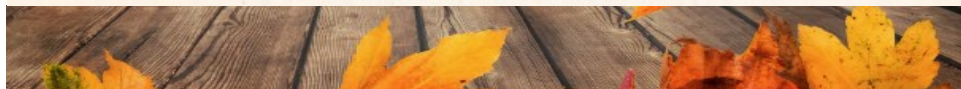

2. What definition would you give to explain the "kingdom of God? Why do you think that Jesus uses the banquet party image for His kingdom?

3. Do you think that it was fair for the king to kick the man out for not having the right clothes? why or why not?

4. Do you think that belief in Jesus must always lead to the behaviour of Jesus and, if not, we must leave the party?

5. Is the question, "what would Jesus do?", helpful to you? Do you consider it a useful guide for your behaviour?
