- 2. Why do you think God included ordinary people like goldsmiths, perfumers, and families in the rebuilding of the wall?
- 3. How does this chapter show that every person's role mattered?

Applying the Word

- 4. In Nehemiah 3, many people built the section of wall closest to their homes. What does that teach us about starting with what's "near to us"?
- 5. At *The Gate*, what might it look like if every person took ownership of a small "section" of the church's mission?
- 6. What excuses keep people from serving ("I'm not skilled," "I'm too busy," etc.)? How can we overcome them?

Going Deeper

- 7. Hebrews 6:10 says, "God is not unjust; He will not forget your work and the love you have shown Him." How does this encourage you to serve faithfully—even if unnoticed?
- 8. If you could take one step this week to "pick up your tools" and help rebuild *The Gate*, what would it be?
