

ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL TUESDAY, JULY 15, 2025 (REVISED)

ATTENDANCE: Chad Christensen (Pastor), Beth Hanggi (SPRC), Kelly Amunrud (Trust Fund), Lisa O'Neil (Ad Council Chairperson), Tyler Kispert (Treasurer).

MEETING: Lisa called the meeting to order and Pastor Chad opened the meeting with a prayer.

SECRETARY: The June Ad Council minutes were distributed. Motion was made to approve the minutes. Motion was seconded and approved.

TREASURER: End of June balance \$17,537.44. (Set aside for parsonage \$7,615.11). Memorial fund end of June balance \$18,736.77. Rev. Buller was paid for preaching. There was a coffee pot replaced in the kitchen which was decided will be paid out of Memorial fund as there was money set aside for that. Effective immediately, check reimbursement will be done on the 1st Sun and 3rd Tues typically, otherwise net 30 days. TRUST FUND: No statement available. Q2 giving was \$15,761.66. Our updated weekly needed amount is \$2,211. It was brought up that the church needs to have tuck point done to the brick. This will come out of the Trust Fund. Kelly is checking with someone who does this to get a quote. TRUSTEES:

Parsonage: There was a broken spigot and the tenants fixed it but was also found all the outside spigots needed replacing. They did not notify us and asked if we could pay the rest of the bill as they had paid part of it. The board discussed and agreed to pay the balance. There will be a discussion that any future repairs have to come through us first.

Basement toilet: Beaver plumbing was able to fix the toilets and installed a grab bar.

Flooring: It was brought to the board that the bathroom flooring be replaced. This will be postponed as a discussion until Fall.

Door lock: The West door keypad is broken. The board voted to replace it as well as install a keypad at the East door.

SPRC: Pastor Chad has met with Michelle Hargrave for his evaluation. Beth will schedule to meet with the Pastor. Lisa and Beth will also be scheduling a walk through of the parsonage.

PASTOR: (See page 2) OTHER BUSINESS:

- August Community Dinner / worship/potluck: We will have a joint worship/potluck on August 10th at 8:30 AM at the North Park Pavilion. Lisa will make a sign to hang up ahead of time.
- Banners: Janet requested to buy some new banners for the church. This was approved.
- UMC survey: This was tabled until a later meeting. Results online and on paper were very similar.
