



Life Group Study Questions Acts 21:17-26

1. Read Acts 21:17-26 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
2. Have you ever delivered news to someone and immediately received pushback? (Paul delivers news to the Jerusalem elders and a problem is brought up) Is it discouraging when this happens? How did you respond?
3. What are some "rights/freedoms" in Christ that can easily become points of division? Have you ever forced someone to agree with your "secondary" issue? Why or why not?
4. Does having unity among fellow believers mean that we have to all agree on everything? What are examples of secondary issues believers can respectfully disagree over?
5. How do you feel about laying down your rights for the sake of other believers? Is this easy or hard to do?
6. What are some things you need to let go of in order to have unity in the body of Christ?
7. Do you believe God will work ALL things for good to accomplish his will in and through you? Do you think its only the good things in your life? Has God used hard things or even evil things in your life to accomplish his purposes?
