Text: Luke 16:1-15 and v19-31

Key Ideas from the Sermon:

- God is the ultimate owner of all things, including our resources, which are entrusted to us by God for our use and for the benefit of others, both physically and spiritually.
- We are to use wealth to make friendships for eternity.
- Love must be our motivation. To think that we can use the wealth of this world, which is ultimately meaningless, for the purpose of helping people find God and relivee suffering, is the greatest privilege and in God's eyes an honest use of wealth.

Bible Study: The Swedish Method [Luke 16]

- 1. Begin by praying, asking God to speak through His Word
- 2. Read the Bible passage aloud, being careful to read slowly
- 3. Go back over the passage (allow about 10 minutes of silence), being on the lookout for, and making notes on the following four things:



Light bulb: This should be something that 'shine 'from the passage - whatever impacts most, or draws attention.
