WFFK - 3: I PROMISE - YOU HAVE A FUTURE

Everyone is interested in their future - it's the destination most of us focus on but there are two realities about the future - number one, we don't know what it's going to be, and two, we can't control it. So, we should definitely be interested in what God has to say about our future.

God knows what will happen; His plan for our future is a good one and He'll be with us every step of the way ... and we are just asked to trust or put faith in Him to enter it. But when we trust -He promises to be with us - to provide a way out when tempted and support us when we face trouble.

- 1. What's the longest power outage you've ever experienced? How did you deal with the outage? What frustrated you the most about it?
- 2. How do you feel about God's plans for your future? Do you find it easy to trust and obey God with your future? What makes it easy and what makes it difficult to trust?
- 3. Read 1 Corinthians 10:13 When we believe our temptations condemn us, we feel shame. How does God's word help us to recognize and reject this lie?
 - 4. Read Isaiah 43:2-3 Think of a difficult season where your future seemed hopeless. Looking back, how did God kept His promise to support you in trouble?
- 5. Read Jeremiah 29:4-11 In this passage what is the context for God's promise of plans for good? What does it mean to "go and dwell?" What hesitations do you have about "going and dwelling?"
