Yes, you will be a peacemaker, but you'll be a, too.
Invariably in the life of the believer who lives out the Beatitude character, there is going to be a reaction in the world.
Three distinct features to this last Beatitude, which stand out in verses 10, 11, and 12. First of all is, secondly is promise, and thirdly is posture.
I believe that verses 10 and 11 are one Beatitude.
I believe that Godblesses those who suffer, those who are persecuted.
The more you live for Christ, the more likely you are to create a in the world.
Nothing has changed; nothing will change. He that is born of the flesh will always persecute he that is born of the Spirit.
