**Sermon Series: The Build – An Exploration into Nehemiah**

**Sermon Theme: “Vision and Favour”**

**Primary Text(s): Nehemiah 2:1-10.**

1. **Read Nehemiah 2:1-10.**
2. *In the sermon, the idea of a vision rising out of a burden is emphasised. What burdens or longings in your life might God be shaping into vision right now?*
3. *Nehemiah waited before acting on his burden (he prayed, fasted, and planned). Why might God delay our “green light”? What lessons are found in that waiting?*
4. *The sermon highlights how Nehemiah asked for permission, provision, protection—and then received them because “the gracious hand of God was upon him.” What does it mean for God’s favour to open doors we cannot open ourselves?*
5. *Where in your life do you currently need favor from God — whether in relationships, opportunities, health, or community?*
6. *How do you balance “doing your part” (preparation, prayer, effort) with trusting God for his hand to move on your behalf?*
7. *What is one step you feel led to take (even a small one) toward a vision God may be giving you this week?*
