

"FAITH AND FAMILY: GOD'S GRACE AND MERCY IN AN EVIL WORLD"

1.	EVIL IS KNOCKING AT YOUR But before they lay down, the men of the city, the men of Sodom, both young and old, all the people to the last man, <u>surrounded the house</u> . ⁵ And they called to Lot, "Where are the men who came to you tonight? Bring them out to us, that we may know them." (Genesis 19:4-5)
	Be sober-minded; be watchful. Your adversary the devil prowls around like a roaring lion, seeking someone to devour. (1 Peter 5:8)
2.	EVIL CREATES DILEMMAS. Lot went out to the men at the entrance, shut the door after him, ⁷ and said, "I beg you, my brothers, <u>do not act so wickedly</u> . ⁸ Behold, I have two daughters who have not known any man. Let me bring them out to you, and do to them as you please. Only do nothing to these men, for they have come under the shelter of my roof." (Genesis 19:6-8)
3.	EVIL CONSTANTLY ACCUSES OF WRONG. But they said, "Stand back!" And they said, "This fellow came to sojourn, and he has become the judge! Now we will deal worse with you than with them." Then they pressed hard against the man Lot and drew near to break the door down. (Genesis 19:9)
	And I heard a loud voice in heaven, saying, "Now the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God and the authority of his Christ have come, for the accuser of our brothers has been thrown down, who accuses them day and night before our God. (Revelations 12:10)
4.	GOD A WAY THROUGH IT. But the men reached out their hands and brought Lot into the house with

them and shut the door. ¹¹And they struck with blindness the men who were at the entrance of the house, both small and great, so that they

wore themselves out groping for the door. (Genesis 19:10-11)

5. JESUS CARES AND GIVES US ______.

For we do not have a <u>high priest</u> who is unable to <u>sympathize</u> with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin. (Hebrews 4:15)

Then the men said to Lot, "Have you anyone else here? Sons-in-law, sons, daughters, or anyone you have in the city, bring them out of the place. ¹³For we are about to destroy this place, because the outcry against its people has become great before the LORD, and the LORD has sent us to destroy it." ¹⁴So Lot went out and said to his sons-in-law, who were to marry his daughters, "Up! Get out of this place, for the LORD is about to destroy the city." But he seemed to his sons-in-law to be jesting. ¹⁵As morning dawned, the angels urged Lot, saying, "Up! Take your wife and your two daughters who are here, lest you be swept away in the punishment of the city." ¹⁶But he lingered. So the men seized him and his wife and his two daughters by the hand, the LORD being merciful to him, and they brought him out and set him outside the city. ¹⁷And as they brought them out, one said, "Escape for your life. Do not look back or stop anywhere in the valley. Escape to the hills, lest you be swept away." (Genesis 19:12-17)

Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap. (Galatians 6:7) (Ref. Romans 6:1-2)

The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance. ¹⁰But the day of the Lord will come like a thief, and then the heavens will pass away with a roar, and the heavenly bodies will be burned up and dissolved, and the earth and the works that are done on it will be exposed. (2 Peter 3:9-10)
