

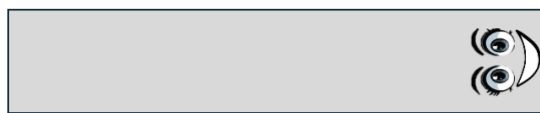
# Blowing in the Wind



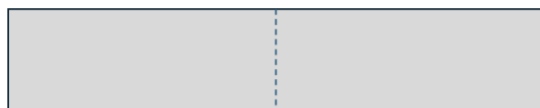
1. Each player needs to cut out their Wonderful Worms
2. Each contestant folds their worm them as per instructions below  
*Note: Teacher could make these prior to the session and save time if needed)*
3. Using a straw, each contestant blows the back of their worm down and then lets their worm “pop up” and slowly inch their way along the table.
4. First player to blow their worm from one end of the table to the other is the winner.

You could use tape to draw a start line and a finish line.

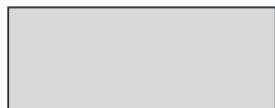
1. Start with the cut-out worm.



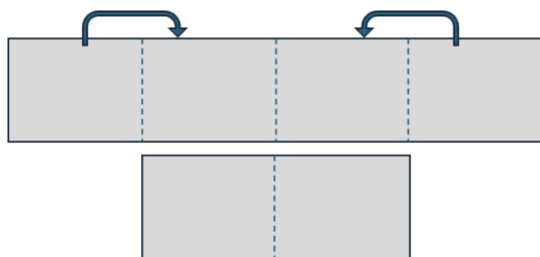
2. Turn it over so face is down.



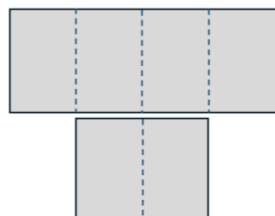
3. Fold in the middle.



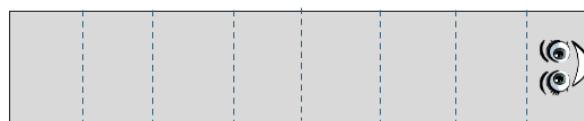
4. Now, open it up and fold the two ends into the middle lie.



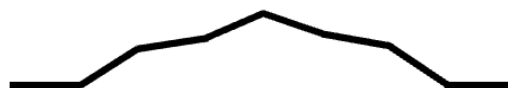
5. Repeat the last step.



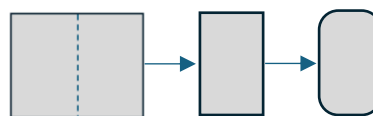
6. Unfold the Worm.



From the side it should look something like this.



7. Use a straw and blow on it near the back to flatten it. Stop blowing and let it spring up and “jump forward.” Continue until you reach the finish line.



**Bonus:** if you want to make it look more like a worm or caterpillar, you can round the corners off with scissors when you have it all folded.
