children in Denison ISD. These bags ensure students have nutritious food over the weekends when school meals aren't available. This rapidly expanding ministry needs volunteers for multiple roles: driving, picking up supplies, unloading, sorting, distributing, restocking, and preparing the weekend food bags.
