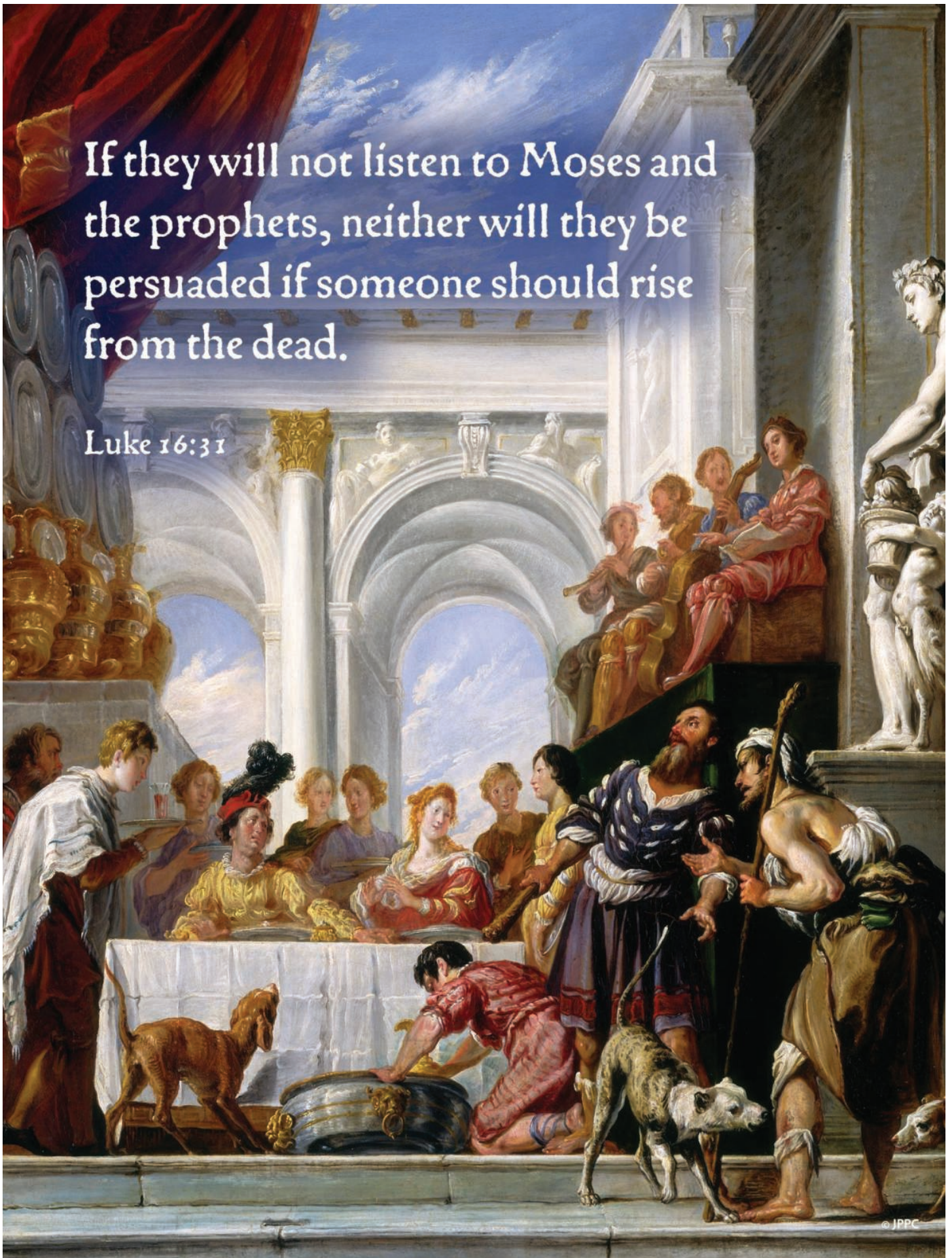

FORTY HOURS DEVOTION – October 6, 7, 8

The first diocesan program of the Forty Hours Devotion in the United States began at the Church of St. Philip Neri in Philadelphia on May 26, 1853. On that date, the Feast of Corpus Christi, Bishop John Neumann (1811-1860)—now St. John Neumann—introduced the devotion at this church in honor of our patron, St. Philip Neri, who had introduced the Forty Hours Devotion in Rome three centuries before. “Of all devotions, that of adoring Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament is the greatest after the sacraments, the one dearest to God and the one most helpful to us.” St. Alphonsus Ligouri. We continue this devotion here at St. Philip Neri each year. We pray that you will join us these three nights, October 6, 7, 8, or even one, to celebrate this Eucharistic devotion. 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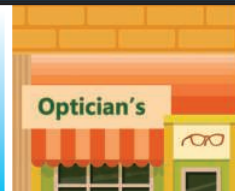
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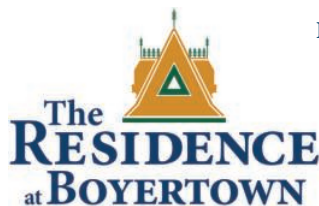
