
2025 The Rich Man and Lazarus Sept 28

Theme; Salvation

Scripture; Luke 16:19-31 "If they will not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not listen even if someone rises from the dead."

Kid's Talk Object; bell, pillows, and

stickers.



Let's play a little game. First snuggle up on your pillow. 'I'm going to ring my bell. I want you to wake up, and tell me what this little monkey is doing. X3

Cover your eyes (see no evil,) cover your ears (hear no evil) cover your mouth (speak no evil). (see pictures on page 10)

God has a reward for those of us who follow His rules.

EARS	Did you know that God sometimes sounds a "wake up" bell in our lives? God wants us to hear the child who cries at school. He speaks to our heart and says, "It is time to wake up and hear what I hear."
EYES	Some people tend to "sleep in" and fall back to sleep. But God wants us to see the child at school who has no lunch today. God speaks to our heart and says, "Wake up! It's time to see what I see."
MOUTH.	Some people turn on their radio and sing along so that they don't even hear God's voice anymore. God speaks to our heart and says, "It's time to Wake up! And tell others to help us to make a better world."

That is what happens in our Bible story today.

Jesus told a story about a rich man who wore the finest clothes and lived in luxury. And a beggar named Lazarus who lay outside the rich man's gate. Lazarus was hungry and his body was covered with sores. He was hoping that the rich man might have pity on him and that he might be able to satisfy his hunger with the leftovers from the rich man's table. But every day the rich man passed by Lazarus, He covered his eyes so he could not see a problem, He covered his ears so he could not hear a problem and covered his mouth so he could not speak a word to Lazarus.

Then he <u>reminded the rich man</u> how he had enjoyed such good things on earth, but he shared <u>nothing</u> with Lazarus!


Let us pray that we will listen to His voice and follow Him before it is too late.

Instead, let us rise and shine and follow You. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen


Lets Sing; Jesus asks us......

STORY ETCHINGS:


You will need; 1 piece of paper, stapler, crayons or coloured pencils. A print out of the story below.
