What is "Death," "Hades," and "the Lake of Fire"?

Wednesday - Revelation 21 Why is the sea no more? (v. 1)
What is the New Jerusalem? (vv. 1—27)
What is the reward for Christians? (vv. 1-27)
Thursday - Revelation 22
Where else is the tree of life in Scripture? (v. 2)
How does one keep the words of the prophecy of this book? (v. 7)
What does it mean that the Lord Jesus is coming soon? (v. 20)
