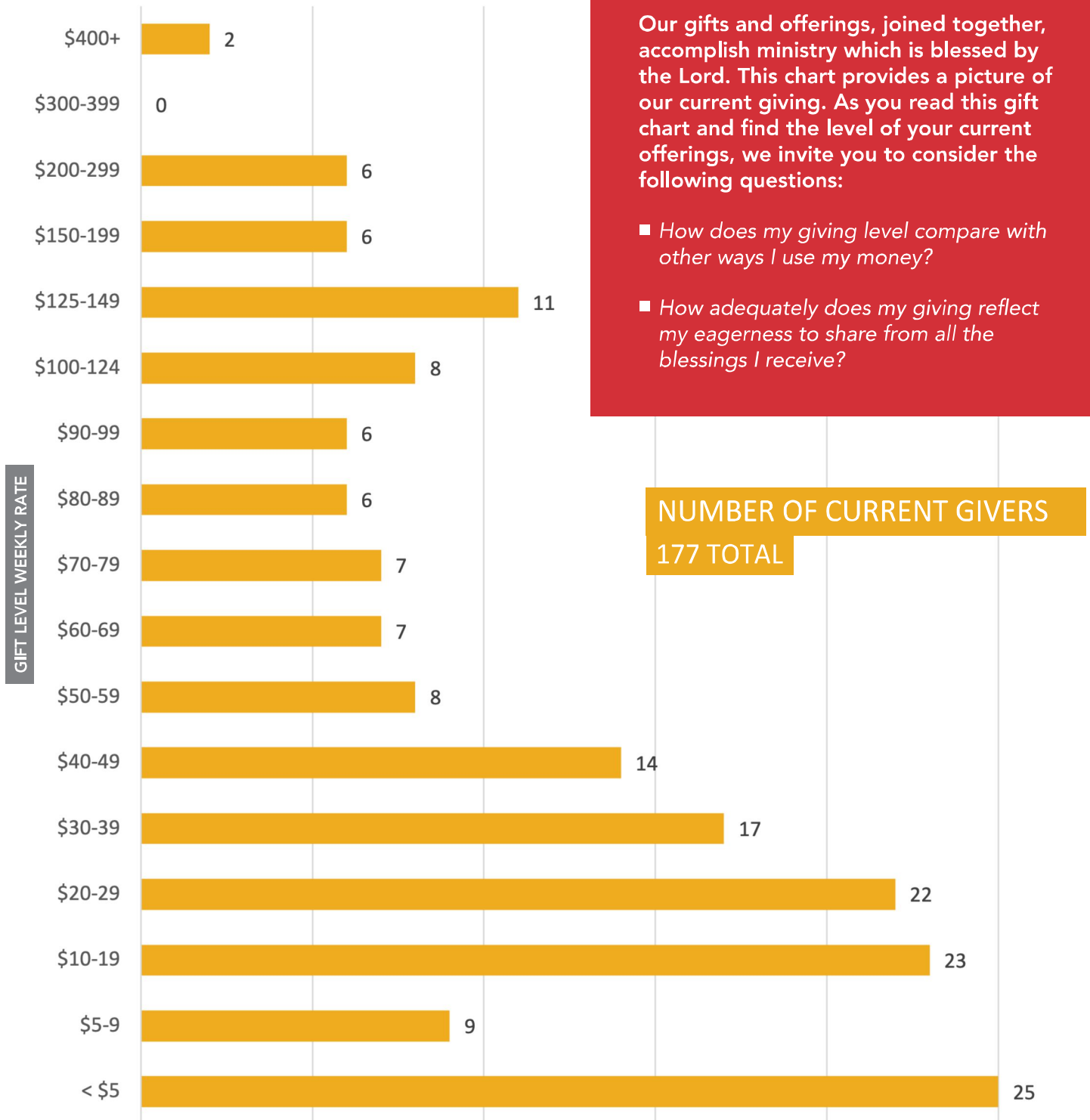


PRINCE OF PEACE LUTHERAN CHURCH
