Quiet Time Questions: September 7, 2025

Begin your study each day with prayer. Ask the LORD to help you focus and understand what you are studying.

MAIN POINT OF THIS WEEK'S PASSAGE: The Apostle Paul's letter to the church at Colossae instructs us as believers to know Jesus as our everything, that we might be firmly established in our faith.

MEMORY VERSE FOR THE WEEK: "Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving." (Colossians 2:6-7)

Day 1. Read Colossians 1:3-6, 2 Corinthians 3:17-18, and Matthew 13:31-32.

As you look at your life today, how has the gospel born fruit and increased in it, from the day that you first believed? How do you see the gospel bearing fruit and increasing in the people of Immanuel? How do you see the gospel bearing fruit and increasing through other churches and ministries, local and universal? In what ways will you give thanks to God, and continue in prayer?

Day 2. Read Colossians 2:1-5, Matthew 6:21, and Colossians 3:16.

It is written that in Christ "are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge." Do you find yourself treasuring him above all else? Why or why not? What role does God's Word play in growing to treasure Christ supremely?

Day 3. Read Colossians 2:6-8 and John 15:1-11.

What does it mean for you to "walk in Christ"? What worldly deceptions do you feel most often try to lead you away from intimacy with Christ?

Day 4. Read Colossians 2:6-15 together as a family devotional. Talk about all of the things Christ has done for you (key phrases: "in him", "with him", etc). Discuss any next steps of faith, as God continues to establish faith in you.
