***The Priority of God***

**What God's Names Tell Me**

**1. God wants to \_\_\_\_\_**

"God is my Provider." (Jehovah-Jireh) (Genesis 22:14)

God will supply all that you need from his glorious riches in Christ Jesus.  
(Philippians 4:19, Ph)

As you know him better, God will give you, through his great power, everything you need for living a truly good life; he even shares his own glory and his own goodness with us! (2 Peter 1:3, TLB)

**2. God wants to \_\_\_\_\_**

"God is my Righteousness." (Jehovah-Tsidkenu) (Jeremiah 23:6)

"I am the God who forgives your sins, and I do this because of who I am."  
(Isaiah 43:25, GNB)

All have sinned; all fall short of God's glorious ideal; yet now God declares us 'not guilty' of offending him if we trust in Jesus Christ, who in his kindness freely takes away our sins. (Romans 3:23-24, TLB)

"God is my Peace." (Jehovah-Shalom) (Judges 6:24)

God is not a God of confusion but of peace. (1 Corinthians 14:33, RSV)

"The peace I give you isn't fragile like the peace the world gives. So don't be troubled or afraid." (John 14:27, TLB)

**4. God wants to \_\_\_\_\_**

"God is my Healer." (Jehovah-Rophe) (Exodus 15:26)

"He heals the brokenhearted and binds up their wounds." (Psalm 147:3)

"When someone becomes a Christian he becomes a brand new person inside. He is not the same anymore. A new life has begun!" (2 Cor. 5:17)

## **My response to today's message**

*Information without application falls short of God's best for us. He wants us to apply what we learn so that we will change and grow, becoming more like Christ. The following questions are for personal and group study, with these goals in mind.*

- 1)** Read and pray Matthew 6:9-13, praising God's name with The Lord's Prayer.
- 2)** Before we ask for our needs, we need to remember and reflect on God's name. What does it mean to "hallow" God's name?
- 3)** God's name stands for His Person. What should be your response to God's name? (Psalm 113:2)
- 4)** How serious is God about the misuse of His name? (Exodus 20:7)
- 5)** How should all people respond to God's name? (1 Kings 8:43)
- 6)** What happens among non-Christians when God's name is glorified? (1 Chronicles 17:24)
- 7)** What should be the Christian's response to God's name? (Nehemiah 9:5; Psalm 111:9; Isaiah 6:3; John 4:23-24)
- 8)** Review and discuss What God's Names Tell Me, focusing on the four references to God's names and the application of each name. Take some time to worship God your Provider... your Righteousness... your Peace... your Healer.

*Pray with and for one another in your small group, focusing on how you can implement "Prayer—Care—Share" this week. Who is your One? Pray that we will strive and thrive to know Christ and make Him known.*
