- 3. How does the principle of SOLIDARITY help us to interpret and understand the kingdoms of earth and the kingdom of Christ?
- 4. How is this final form of the Roman empire different than previous kingdoms (7:19-21)?
- 5. How is the Antichrist different and greater than any world ruler that has come before?
- 6. Daniel 7:25b says, "and they will be given into his hand for a time, times, and half a time." Explain what you think it means that the Antichrist will have a set time to carry out his assault on the saints.
- 7. God will judge the Antichrist and the final Roman empire. It will be annihilated and destroyed. Is there a comfort in this, and if so, what?
- 8. What kind of kingdom will believers in Christ ultimately possess?
