Spiritual Growth Opportunities in Student Ministry

We are now in the season of Fall. It's a new season in the Student Ministry. School has been in session for several weeks. The leaves will start to turn. There are several spiritual growth opportunities in the Student Ministry.

Each Sunday there is Sunday School for all ages. It starts at 10 a.m. There is a 3 yr.-5 yr. old class, K-2nd grade class, 3rd-5th grade class, and youth class (middle and high school together). All of these classes meet upstairs. For several years, these classes (except for the 3 yr.-5yr. old class) went through the Answers and Genesis curriculum. We just finished it back in the summer. The last several weeks we have been testing out new curriculum. The K-2nd grade class and 3rd-5th grade class will be going through the Gospel Project. This curriculum starts with Genesis and goes through Revelation. The youth class will be going will be going through Bible Studies For Life. These are more topical studies. There is nursery during Sunday School.

There is Team Kid during the Contemporary Service on Sunday Mornings. This is for children 3 yr.old-5th grade. The children come into the service for worship and then right before the preaching, the children are dismissed to go to the gym. During this time, we start off with a game or activity. We have a bible lesson and we finish Team Kid with a craft. There is nursery during the Contemporary Service upstairs.

On Wednesday Night, the children (3yr.old-5th grade) meet upstairs across from the 3rd-5th grade room. They are going through the" Good News Curriculum." The youth (6th-12th grade) meet in the gym. We usually start off with a game, then bible lesson, sometimes sing a worship song, and then do small groups. The girls and guys meet separately after bible lesson. During this time, the youth are given a sheet of paper with questions that pertain to the lesson. They answer those questions and each group talk through the questions and then pray.

Also, each month there is a students event calendar that has the events for the month. You can pick one up by the gym. If you haven't connected to where you get a text message with reminders going on in student ministry, you can use the QR code in the bulletin.

Fall Festival will be Friday October 31st from 6 PM - 8 PM. There was a Fall Festival meeting this past Sunday. There will be trunk or treat, inflatables, games in the gym, gospel presentation. costume contest, pumpkin decorating contest (Bring pumpkins already decorated), and there will be a big prize giveaway. We do need help with the Fall Festival. There are signup sheets by gym. Make sure to sign up.
