#### Psalm 10:4 (NKJV)

The wicked in his proud countenance does not seek *God;*God *is* in none of his thoughts.

#### Proverbs 11:2 (NKJV)

When pride comes, then comes shame;
But with the humble *is* wisdom.

#### Proverbs 16:18 (NKJV)

<sup>18</sup> Pride *goes* before destruction, And a haughty spirit before a fall.

### Luke 18:9–14 (NKJV)

#### Parable of the Pharisee and the Tax Collector

<sup>9</sup> Also He spoke this parable to some who trusted in themselves that they were righteous, and despised others: <sup>10</sup> "Two men went up to the temple to pray, one a Pharisee and the other a tax collector. <sup>11</sup> The Pharisee stood and prayed thus with himself, 'God, I thank You that I am not like other men—extortioners, unjust, adulterers, or even as this tax collector. <sup>12</sup> I fast twice a week; I give tithes of all that I possess.' <sup>13</sup> And the tax collector, standing afar off, would not so much as raise *his* eyes to heaven, but beat his breast, saying, 'God, be merciful to me a sinner!' <sup>14</sup> I tell you, this man went down to his house justified *rather* than the other; for everyone who exalts himself will be humbled, and he who humbles himself will be exalted."

#### Proverbs 29:23 (NKJV)

<sup>23</sup> A man's pride will bring him low, But the humble in spirit will retain honor.

**pride** n. — unreasonable and inordinate self-esteem.

Pride refers to an unwarranted attitude of confidence. While pride can have a positive connotation of self-worth or boasting, it is often used in Scripture to refer to an unhealthy elevated view of oneself, abilities, or possessions.

**false pride** n. — a self-exalting, self-absorbed conceit of one's own superiority; especially one that believes that all achievements are of their own doing.

#### 1 Peter 5:6-7 (NKJV)

<sup>6</sup> Therefore humble yourselves under the mighty hand of God, that He may exalt you in due time, <sup>7</sup> casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

# Philippians 2:5–8 (NKJV) The Humbled and Exalted Christ

<sup>5</sup> Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, <sup>7</sup> but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, *and* coming in the likeness of men. <sup>8</sup> And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to *the point of* death, even the death of the cross.

#### James 4:6 (NKJV)

But He gives more grace. Therefore He says: "God resists the proud, But gives grace to the humble."

#### Proverbs 11:2 (NKJV)

#### Philippians 2:9-11 (NKJV)

<sup>9</sup> Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, <sup>10</sup> that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, <sup>11</sup> and *that* every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ *is* Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
