- What does this passage teach us about God's role in spiritual or life "battles"? How much is ours to do, and how much is God's?
- What are Bible verses you go to when you feel hopeless?
- What are practical ways we can live out: Faith focuses on God and not the circumstances?

General Fund to the end of August

Year-end adjustments reduced our General Fund balance by \$5,525 due to purchases of that amount that went into capital assets. Income was low in August, being almost \$8,500 under budget. Expenses were also under budget, but by a lesser amount. Our deficit of \$3,756.46 reduces the General Fund balance to just over \$80,000. Our grade remains an A, but we are now \$10,000 below an A+.

The large percentage drop in income from last year is because we received a special \$30,000 gift in 2024, which made last year's results exceptionally strong. Expenses will climb significantly in September as we begin a new ministry year and pay our annual property and liability insurance premium. Thank you for worshipping God through your gifts to support His work at PTC.
