One of the Most Amazing Rescues That I Have Ever Heard About Happened in Coolidge Arizona Back in the Spring of 1987

- -> There Was Parachutist Convention There Sponsored by Skydive Arizona
- Debbie Williams, a 31 Year Old 5th Grade School Teacher From Post, Texas, With 50 Jumps to Her Credit, Jumped Out of a DC-9 That Was Flying at an Altitude of 9,000 Feet
- She Was Trying to Meet Up With Another Group of Skydivers in a Formation, But Something Went Terribly Wrong
- -> She Collided With Another One of the Skydivers and Was Knocked Unconscious
- -> Gregory Robertson, a Parachuting Instructor, With 1700 Jumps to His Credit, Had Assumed a Position 40 Feet Above the Other Divers
- -> He Saw What Had Happened, and He Saw Debbie Williams Falling Like a Ragdoll to the Ground
- So, He Immediately Straightened His Body Into a Vertical Dart, With His Arms Pinned to His Body, His Feet Crossed and His Head Aimed Towards the Ground in What Chutist Call a "No Lift" Dive
- -> He Plummeted Towards Williams at a Speed of 200 mph
- -> At 3,500 Feet, Only 10 Seconds Before Impact, Robertson Caught Up With Williams and Began Angling Her Body so That Her Parachute Could Open
- -> At 2,000 Feet, Just 6 Seconds Before Impact, Robertson Managed to Pull Williams Ripcord, and Then, His Own
- -> Fortunately, Robertson Walked Away Without Any Injuries, and He Resumed Skydiving
- -> Williams, on the Other Hand, Suffered a Skull Fracture, 9 Broken Ribs and a Perforated Kidney, But She Did Survive
