



Life Group Study Questions Acts 21:27-22:29

1. Read Acts 21:27-22:29 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
2. Have you ever had an experience when you were misrepresented or attacked because of your belief in Jesus? How did you handle it?
3. Pastor Andrew's first point was: "There will be people who misrepresent and attack you because of Jesus." Read John 15:18-25. Why is it important to remind yourself of this fact?
4. Pastor Andrew's second point was: "You can and should be winsome in your evangelism." What examples from our passage show Paul's winsomeness? Who is a modern person who exemplifies this well?
5. Read Matthew 10:16-20. How could you grow in your winsomeness with the gospel?
6. Pastor Andrew's third point was: "Do not underestimate the power of God's story in your life." Have you ever shared your testimony with someone?
7. As you think about your story, how can you make it more Christ-focused instead of you-focused?
8. Pastor Andrew's fourth point was: "In your winsomeness, do not forsake the truth." What are the big areas that Christians are tempted to do this in?
9. Is it possible to stand firm on the truth but to do so in a loving way? Is there an area where you have softened the truth in order to "be loving"?
