

Life Group Study Questions Acts 21:27-22:29

- 1. Read Acts 21:27-22:29 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
- 2. Have you ever had an experience when you were misrepresented or attacked because of your belief in Jesus? How did you handle it?
- 3. Pastor Andrew's first point was: "There will be people who misrepresent and attack you because of Jesus." Read John 15:18-25. Why is it important to remind yourself of this fact?
- 4. Pastor Andrew's second point was: "You can and should be winsome in your evangelism." What examples from our passage show Paul's winsomeness? Who is a modern person who exemplifies this well?
- 5. Read Matthew 10:16-20. How could you grow in your winsomeness with the gospel?
- 6. Pastor Andrew's third point was: "Do not underestimate the power of God's story in your life." Have you ever shared your testimony with someone?
- 7. As you think about your story, how can you make it more Christ-focused instead of you-focused?
- 8. Pastor Andrew's fourth point was: "In your winsomeness, do not forsake the truth." What are the big areas that Christians are tempted to do this in?
- 9. Is it possible to stand firm on the truth but to do so in a loving way? Is there an area where you have softened the truth in order to "be loving"?
