Knowing this, we can share all we have with our neighbors, even our very place and salvation, confident that God will continue to provide for our needs.




RISE AGAINST HUNGER MEAL PACKAGING EVENT, OCT. 19: **REGISTER NOW!**

The annual Rise Against Hunger meal packaging event will be held on Sunday, October 19. According to our liaisons at Rise Against Hunger, our packaging event is the second largest community event in our region.

As of press time, 138 volunteers have signed up (51% of the 300 volunteers we need), and we've raised \$18,047.25 (75% of our goal...we still need to raise \$6,052.75 to purchase the 60,000 meals to be packaged on Oct. 19). THE STABLES FAMILY NIGHT OUT, OCT. 3 DINE & DONATE FOR ST. MATTHEW'S SCHOOL


