We know exactly what lands God promised to Israel.

This covenant binds God to fulfillment and I believe He must/will give the land to Israel.

His covenant has a fantastic series of promises.

God's not really in the business of making deals with people. Sometimes there are exceptions, apparently, to that. But for the most part, God swears by Himself. And God binds Himself by Himself. God makes covenants with Himself.
