

This 4-hour training course is the first step in becoming eligible to serve as a religious volunteer within the Fresno County Jail Chaplaincy Unit.

New volunteers will be scheduled to serve on a weekly basis as they host 1-hour chapels within the jail.



Sensitivity for the Soul

We continuously pray the Lord's will be done. In service to the Most High, we pray daily for humility. It's not easy ministering to the incarcerated. It's not easy encouraging the Church to serve in jails, prisons, or in the streets.

A member of the ministry recently said, "The heart of the ministry is to reach the unreachable". Our prayer is that we see people the way God sees them. As our identities are in Christ, the desire of our heart is to encourage and motivate authentic followers of Jesus to

get uncomfortable in the practice of self-denial for the sake of God & others. It's noticeable how this practice of humility allows for a full surrender and commitment to the Lord. Can I deny myself more each day? Is it possible to worship God more today than I did yesterday? When I stop denying myself, I become complacent.

"He must become greater and greater, and I must become less and less." (John 3:30).

As the world witnessed the assassination of Charlie Kirk, it pushed me into prayer. The Holy Spirit broke my heart for the Kirks, our society, humanity, and for Tyler Robinson. Tyler, who at this point, most likely does not know the Lord, is heavy on my heart. Is this because I see myself in him; once in bondage of sin, living by the flesh? Having the awareness that his soul is at risk of perishing draws me into a state of rich intercessory prayer.

This ministry regularly ministers to criminals, offenders, and those condemned by society who are deemed as "unreachable". I am led to wonder, where do I draw the line of sacrificial love? Aren't all people worthy of reaching for? Better yet *out-reaching* for? The Holy Spirit has brought me to a burdened, compassionate, desperate, place of intercessory prayer for Tyler.

"Then Jesus said, "Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do." (Luke 23:34)

As I prayed, the Holy Spirit broke my heart for the Church as well. When was the last time you prayed with someone to accept Jesus Christ as their personal Savior? Doesn't it make sense to think, that Christians who embody the Life of the Gospel, will impact society as salt & light? (Matthew 5:13-16). Do we intercede for others? And at what cost?

We recognize how much of humanity has lost a sense of value for human life, having become insensitive to the flesh, and what of the soul? My eyes well up with tears as I ask, has our Christian, Church culture, become insensitive to the souls of humanity? If it hasn't, wouldn't more followers of Christ be *out-reaching* in such desperate times?

There is need for the Church, to actually be a body who loves God and others; others as the "unreachable". Christ died for all. Imagine, if urgency was normalized within the Church and, if we as *doers of the word (James 1:22-25)*, never balked at sharing the Gospel with strangers, prisoners, and those at risk of perishing! I must take honor in genuinely being an ambassador of Christ, of whom all glory is due!

Let us get uncomfortable and vulnerable as the Holy Spirit of God, in Christ, sensitizes our hearts for those at *rock bottom*; the "unreachable". As the Church, may we not be intimidated by the world, evil, or even our own understanding!

Join us in prayer, October 10th, 8pm, at Dicky Park, in downtown Fresno. We will be praying for those impacted by this recent assassination while intentionally praying for Tyler's salvation in Jesus. Let's build on the Rock of Christ! For He is worthy! (See back panel for detailed flyer).
