The candidate garnered at least a two thirds majority of the Canterbury Crown Nominations Commission. The commission has 17 members – 6 from the General Synod of the Church of England, three from the diocese of Canterbury, the Archbishop of Norwich, the Archbishop of York, and five people representing the rest of the Anglican Communion.

My family and I were overwhelmed with the response to Alfreda's request to support Bentley's Buddies for the annual Walk for Apraxia through apraxia-kids.org. Every year, we raise money and attend the event to celebrate the children who need help finding their voices. The money we collect goes toward research; a support system for families; speech therapy; tablets to assist children with communication; and advanced, intensive training programs for speech-language pathologists, and much more. Bentley has benefited from these services for years. I know many of you have not heard of Apraxia. Childhood Apraxia of Speech (CAS) is a motor speech disorder that makes it difficult for children to speak. Children with the diagnosis of Apraxia of Speech generally have a good understanding of language and know what they want to say. However, they have difficulty learning or carrying out the complex sequenced movements that are necessary for intelligible speech. We are so grateful for your generosity and your support of Bentley.
