



## **MUSIC NOTES**

This morning's music is largely Celtic-inspired, anchored by the mighty hymn *St Patrick's Breastplate*. Legend has it that St. Patrick wrote it in 433 A.D. as a prayer for divine protection before he successfully converted the Irish King Leoghaire and his subjects from paganism to Christianity. The tune we associate with these words is also very ancient, although it was adapted to this text only in the 19th century by the great Anglo-Irish composer Sir Charles Villiers Stanford. The Scottish James MacMillan is one the most important living composers in the English choral tradition; *O Radiant Dawn* from the Strathclyde Motets is normally sung during Advent, but is apt to the Season of Creation also. Stephanie Martin's *Christ be with me* sets an excerpt from St Patrick's Breastplate, and was composed for the funeral of Father Harold Nahabedian.
