P: We enter the silence of Creation!



AUGUST MEETING UPDATE

Since March 2025, members and leaders from Augustana, Bethlehem, First Lutheran, Hope, and Zion have been gathering monthly to explore what it means to be the Church together in changing times.

On August 28th, the Fergus Area Mission meeting included three main discussions.

1) Augustana Invitation to Executive Teams

Augustana's Executive Team invited the other congregations' executive teams (President, Vice President, Treasurer, and Secretary) to a gathering with the focus to continue building relationships.

2) Guidance to the Joint Worship Planning Team

Two members from each participating congregation and pastors will meet to plan a joint worship and outreach event. Locations outside of the church buildings were discussed. The outreach component will be hunger related with two focuses: one hands on project that any age can participate in and a special offering to make a greater impact to the local food shelf.

3) Youth and Family Collaboration

A small group broke off to discuss options for a single event for youth and/or families that could be hosted by all five congregations.

We ask that you join us in prayer for this process, for each of these congregations, and for God's greater work in Fergus Falls.

In September, the **Joint Worship Planning Team** and the **Youth and Family Collaboration Team** will meet to continue their work.
