

# WEEK 1 STARTING ON THE PATH

1 John 1:1-4

- <sup>1</sup> That which was from the beginning, which we have heard, which we have seen with our eyes, which we have looked at and our hands have touched—this we proclaim concerning the Word of life.
- <sup>2</sup> The life appeared; we have seen it and testify to it, and we proclaim to you the eternal life, which was with the Father and has appeared to us.
- <sup>3</sup> We proclaim to you what we have seen and heard, so that you also may have fellowship with us. And our fellowship is with the Father and with his Son, Jesus Christ. <sup>4</sup> We write this to make our joy complete.

There is only one path to eternal life, and that is through Jesus.

What does it look like to follow this Path?

As followers of Jesus, our walk should grow steadier, stronger, and more mature.

- 1 John 1:5-6
- <sup>5</sup> This is the message we have heard from him and declare to you: God is light; in him there is no darkness at all.
- <sup>6</sup> If we claim to have fellowship with him yet walk in the darkness, we lie and do not live by the truth.

There should be consistency between who we say are, and who we actually are.

1 John 1:7

<sup>7</sup> But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus, his Son, purifies us from all sin.

That is the power of staying on the Path: Community and Forgiveness.

Your first steps on the Path are often followed very closely by your first fall.

### We will always fall some, but we should fall less and less along the way.

- 1 John 1:8-10
- 8 If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us.
- <sup>9</sup> If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
- <sup>10</sup> If we claim we have not sinned, we make him out to be a liar and his word has no place in our lives.

# Confess the sin that God already knows you committed and is waiting for you to confess.

### God is faithful...

- 2 Timothy 2:13
- <sup>13</sup> if we are faithless, he will remain faithful, for he cannot disown himself.

### God wants to forgive you and He wants you to get back on the Path.

- 1 John 2:1-2
- <sup>1</sup> My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin. But if anybody does sin, we have one who speaks to the Father in our defense—Jesus Christ, the Righteous one.
- <sup>2</sup> He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not only for ours but also for the sins of the whole world.

### Jesus died and rose again so that we wouldn't stay down.

- 1 John 2:3-6
- <sup>3</sup> We know that we have come to know him if we obey his commands. <sup>4</sup> The man who says, "I know him," but does not do what he commands is a liar, and the truth is not in him. <sup>5</sup> But if anyone obeys his word, God's love is truly made complete in him. This is how we know we are in him. <sup>6</sup> Whoever claims to live in him must walk as Jesus did.

Love for God is best evidenced by obeying His commands.

God doesn't want you to be independent of Him. He wants you to become more dependent on Him.

#### Isaiah 40:30-31

<sup>30</sup> Even youths grow tired and weary, and young men stumble and fall; <sup>31</sup> but those who hope in the Lord will renew their strength. They will soar on wings like eagles; they will run and not grow weary, they will walk and not be faint.
