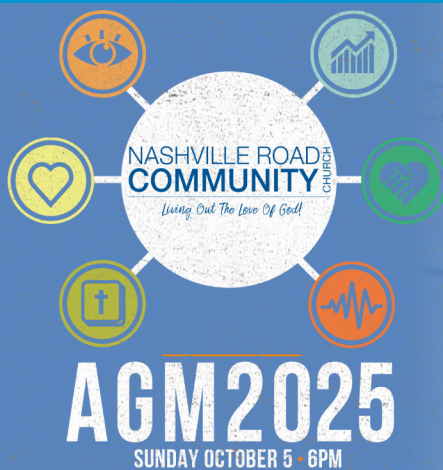
MOVING WITH MUSIC!

Living Out The Love Of God!



Good evening brothers and sisters,

Wish you had a blessed Sunday! Today is our 4th day in Anchorage after we arrived on Wednesday evening. We were picked up at the airport and on the way to the guesthouse, we made a stop for some takeouts. The six hour flight do not include meals.

Following in the next morning around 5am which is 9am EST, we were awake. Normally the fridge is empty, but the hosts bought some eggs and bread for us the day before. It was very thoughtful of her. Later that morning, we met the host, Cassidy and she explains everything to us from where all the keys for the apartments are and the colour coded locks for the four storage sheds in the backyard. The bedsheets are each room are also colour coded so there is no confusion.

We drove around the city in the afternoon to get groceries. Everything are in the close proximity, within 10 minutes drive to all essentials. The neighborhood is safer now after the police cracked down a case and shut down a hotel that was dealing drugs and other crimes. There are some remaining homeless living in the area.

Then on Friday, I had to work remotely while Benny started cleaning up two of the apartments. The guests would put all the sheets and towels in the basket and drop them off at the laundry room. We then put new sheets on the bed for the next guests to use. Taking all the garbage out and make sure the place is clean.

Saturday came and no guests stayed the night before that we need to flip the apartment. So we took the privilege to visit the zoo in the morning. Later that evening, a group of young adults came to stay for the night in two apartments before heading out for their Bible camp the next day. They flew from Tennessee State.

We were able to meet missionaries other then from Send International. A family spent 7 years at Naknet with around 1000 people. Food supplies only come every two months. And some are in more remote places where there is no running water.

Benny and I are getting the hang of the routine but there is more can be done. Such as raking the leaves, power wash the building etc.

Please continue to pray for our hearts to share the gospel when an opportunity comes. Safety on the roads and offer hospitality.

on Mission in Salerno Italy

Greetings from Salerno, Italy.

Thank you for your fellowship and prayer. We appreciate this greatly. The Lord continue to bless your hearts for missions. Thank you again.

The last period has been quite the roller coaster ride of events, of trials and tribulations, holding on tight, then coming out the other end victoriously. Some of the youth are returning! We pray that this will be the case in the churches we are involved in that have experienced or still experiencing the remnant effects of post Covid. We trust that being steadfast in providing opportunities to grow in the Lord with tailor-made teachings that meet the specific needs, and showing grace towards them is what the Lord seems to be using to bring them back. We are hoping they will bring others in with them. With this desire in mind we have created a program called "The Bridge", implementing a youth group meeting every second Saturday evening starting on the 4th of October. Those who are still a little reluctant may find these evenings a safe place where they can be heard out, and we want to be all ears.

The work with the men is moving forward through teaching and mentoring, but what Joe is noticing is that all these leadership principles are driven home better through personal conversations as a brother and friend. Wonderful to see their initiatives carried forward autonomously with conviction and joy without looking to seeking our approval. The church is voicing their appreciation for their preaching and teaching. We have one of the new members that takes notes voraciously and carefully during the bible studies and then posts a written reiteration of what was taught onto our WhatsApp church group. He has a wonderful gift of expanding the thoughts and teachings to render them desirable to read. This is very helpful for all, but especially for those who are not always able to participate. We have had very good feedback.

We will be having a group of students for a day, along with their Director of Studies, from Tilsley Bible College Ireland. We will have fellowship and a Bible teaching day with them where we will also share the work we do in Salerno, have a meal, and then show them around the city of Salerno. We pray that the Lord may send more workers into the field here in Italy.

Loredana's network of women she is helping (emotion healing, salvation and sanctification) praise God it is large, but sometimes difficult to manage. We see the tangible effects with the women who now actively engage in our bible studies, and look to serve within the church body. Actually we start to see their adult children show up to church, and in some cases even offer their services.

We are looking to work with the men in a similar way helping them shed some of the negative traits of their inherited masculinism, like lack of empathy. They are often either aggressive or passive, the two extremes with not much in the middle. That makes it sometimes hard for them to establish healthy relationships. These issues can affect also their relationship with the Lord, and then their church life.

We continue to meet with friends who don't know the Lord where it has become very normal for us to talk about the Lord and salvation with them. There is a new entire family that have come into the picture who seem to have a desire and thirst to hear the things of the Lord Jesus. It is a big family and they practically all expressed their desire to study and know the word of God.
