# Todd's Take

Welcome to worship! What a joy it is to gather together as a church family. To our guests joining us today, we'd love the opportunity to

connect with you.

In our sermon time we will continue our journey through **1** John. In 1 John 2:3-11, John addresses false teachers who denied Jesus' humanity and separated knowledge from obedience. He presents three tests of genuine faith: the (knowing Obedience Test God produces obedience), the Imitation Test (abiding in Christ transforms us to walk like Him), and the Love Test (being in the light means loving others). These tests remain relevant today, warning against reducing faith to mere knowledge, public attendance, or performance. salvation produces transformation—not legalistic obligation, but natural change flowing from encountering Jesus. When we truly know Christ, obedience, Christlike living, and genuine love become our authentic response to His grace.
