WATER UPDATE

EXPANDING WATER COLLECTION POINTS





This month, another land survey was completed by the company contracted to drill the borehole in Sembabule - a critical step toward bringing safe, reliable water to the community.

Additionally, we began expanding and clearing the current water collection points. These improvements will allow families to safely gather more water during the rainy season while ensuring cleaner water, as debris can now settle in a larger body of water. Each step forward brings us closer to lasting solutions for clean water.

PHYSICAL THERAPY SESSIONS







Again this month we have witnessed children continue to grow and thrive with access to physical therapy and support services. Children who were once unable to sit, stand, or walk are now, slowly and steadily, beginning to sit, to stand, and to walk. We have seen hope reignited in their lives and in the eyes of their caregivers: hope for a brighter future.

Most notably, this month we were also able to extend support and services to five elderly community members - a unique opportunity to engage in meaningful conversation, offer encouragement, deepen relationships within the community, and provide a necessary community service.

MORE BRIGHT MOMENTS

- Our 35 children in our sponsorship program have returned to school for term III the final term of the school year! Many heartfelt thanks to our wonderful sponsors who make quality education possible and celebrate each child's growth alongside us.
- We have also expanded our skills training program to ten students learning the craft of tailoring. It has been a joy to witness the growth, dedication, and creativity they display as they develop this new skill.
- And lastly, many months ago, we shared the story of a young girl who had been sexually assaulted by a close family member. Her mother reached out to us for help, and we stood with her - advocating on her behalf, supporting her in the prison and courtroom, and ensuring she could access the necessary counseling and recovery services.

This month, we are overjoyed to share that she has been safely reunited with her family and ensured a supportive environment for her continued healing and growth.
