## Key Ideas from the Sermon:

- Christians are those with a new identity. We are children of God. This relationship with God that comes about through faith in Jesus, means that we now know God as Father- 'dad' even. Personal, intimate, loving.
- There is great security in being a child of God, its like a rock under our feet especially through times of suffering.
- When we consider the future glory that will be revealed in us when Jesus returns and brings about the new creation, Paul says, our present sufferings will not be worth comparing!
- This hope, sure and certain, gives us clam and peace, it means we can wait patiently, despite our sufferings.

Bible Study: The Swedish Method [Romans 8:14-25]

- 1. Begin by praying, asking God to speak through His Word
- 2. Read the Bible passage aloud, being careful to read slowly
- 3. Go back over the passage (allow about 10 minutes of silence), being on the lookout for, and making notes on the following four things:

**Light bulb:** This should be something that 'shine 'from the passage - whatever impacts most, or draws attention.
