1 Samuel 14:24-52

Things to think about:

- Why do you think Saul imposed such a harsh command (a fast during battle)? What might have been his motivations—spiritual, political, personal?
- Saul builds an altar to the Lord (v.35)- his first mentioned altar. Do you think this was a genuine act of worship or a reaction to guilt or pressure? Why?
- Verses 47-52 summarize Saul's military achievements. How do these victories contrast with his moral and spiritual failures? Can external success mask internal decline? Explain.
- What is the difference between being godly and being spiritual? What does being godly look like? What does being spiritual look like?
- If we've been saved, why does it matter that Christ is kept on the throne of our hearts? What does it practically look like to keep Christ on our hearts' throne each day?
