

Life Group Study Questions Acts 22:30-23:11

- 1. Read Acts 22:30-23:11 together. As you think about this weekend's sermon, what stood out to you? What questions come to mind? Was there anything unclear or confusing?
- 2. When you think about the Apostle Paul, do you picture him as near perfect? Someone who never struggled or sinned? Why or why not?
- 3. In what ways do we see Paul's humanity in this passage? (Or in other passages?)
- 4. In what ways do we see Paul's humility in this passage? Is it hard for you to admit when you are wrong?
- 5. How can followers of Jesus speak out against hypocrisy and injustice but in a respectful and submissive manner? (Be practical! How can you respect leaders above you while also voicing your opinion?)
- 6. In verse 6 Paul perceives the council is not united in their beliefs and uses this to his advantage. Do you have discernment to respond differently in different situations? How so?
- 7. How would you share the gospel with an atheist as opposed to a muslim? Would the tactics be different?
- 8. At the end of our passage, we see Jesus comfort Paul by telling him to "take courage". In your own life, what does this look like? How do you take courage in the midst of hardship?
