What Happens on Wednesday Evenings?

Our goal is simple: we want every student to have a close, personal relationship with Jesus. We try to help them grow in three ways—we love, we pray, and we teach. A typical Wednesday night has two parts:

- The first hour: we bond over an activity, games, or just hanging out.
- The second hour: we open the Bible together and learn from God's Word.
