# LIFE GROUP QUESTIONS 1. When you think about the kinds of divisions we see around us—in politics, culture, or even daily preferences—what do you think is at the heart of those divisions? 2. Division in the church could be compared to cracks in a wall's foundation. What "small cracks" (loyalties, preferences, or attitudes) do you think can easily grow into bigger problems in a church if left unchecked? 3. Unity doesn't mean sameness but harmony. What's one way you've seen differences in personality, gifts, or perspectives actually strengthen the church rather than divide it? 4. How can we practice "theological triage" in real life, knowing which issues are essential to unity in Christ and which ones we can disagree on while still walking together in love? 5. Why do you think we're so easily drawn to personalities, preferences, or labels...whether in church, culture, or theology? What does that reveal about our hearts? 6. What are some practical ways we can encourage one another to keep Christ at the center, especially when differences in style, teaching, or theological emphasis come up in our church? 7. Paul asks, "Is Christ divided?" How does division in the church distort the way the world sees Jesus and the gospel? Can you think of examples where this has happened? 8. If our unity reflects the gospel, what is one practical step we could take this week, individually or as a group, to keep Jesus at the center and make Him more visible than our differences?
