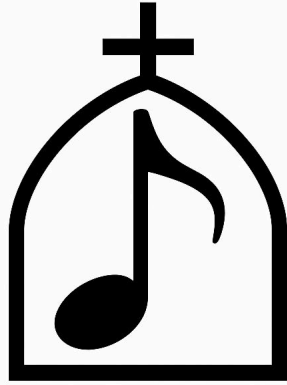



All stand, sit, or kneel for the Litany and Prayers, as is your custom.


