God helps us to be a new people grounded in promise.

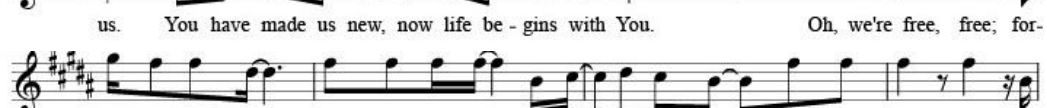
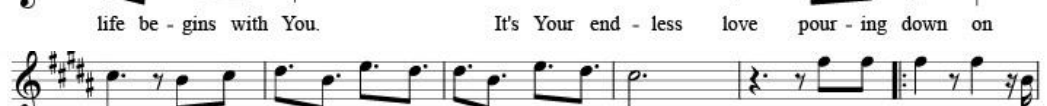
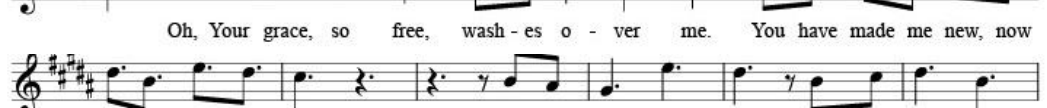
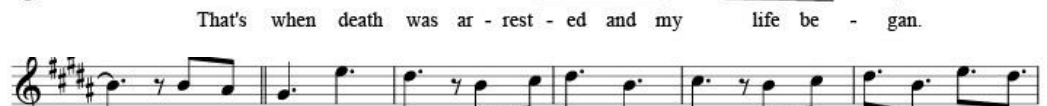
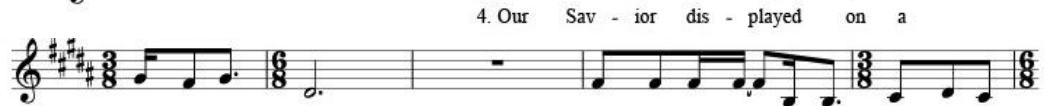
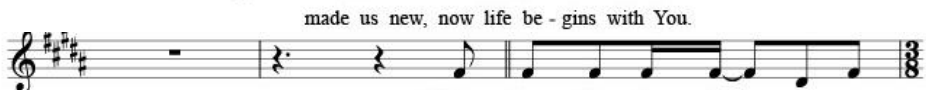
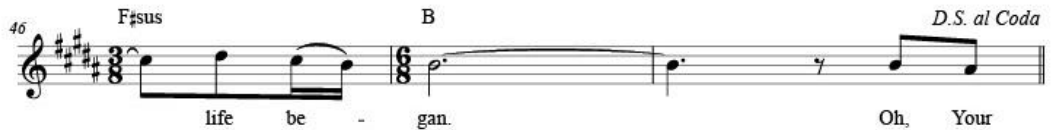
