

Dear Praying Friends,

God gave us a blessed Bible study group yesterday as we looked at the theme of eternity and the vast difference between the saved and lost. It was such a blessing to us to be able to pray together and worship the Lord together with other believers. We have really missed that over the last four years. The children really enjoyed the Bible lesson and craft that Sarah put together for them. It has been good for our children to interact with other children on Sunday and be able to open their home to other people. Our kids are an important part of our ministry here, and we certainly appreciate your prayers for them as they learn to be hospitable and unselfish.

The Lord blessed my time in Nyíregyháza last week as I ministered to Viki and her family during the loss of her father. He was an older man, but his passing was unexpected. Families are a lot closer here than in the States, since most people live near their childhood home and their extended family. Thank you for your continued prayers for them. It is very hard on Viki, as she really wanted to see her father make a profession of faith before his death.

The children continue to do well in school. Katie has been learning how to get along with the other girls in the kindergarten, and Andrew has been working on focusing on his teacher during his handwriting exercises at school. He hasn't had a regular assistant for several weeks now. The school already has 5 assistants, and the government is only mandated to give them 2. That means that the only way to get the government to pay for another assistant is to definitively prove how much Andrew needs one. According to the lady responsible for mental disability evaluations, the only way to do this is to wait 6 months so that they can demonstrate a consistent record of Andrew falling behind the class. I would rather not wait for that. He has been doing a pretty good job so far, but he still struggles with losing focus sometimes. He is speaking much more Hungarian now, even at home, which has been a great development. We just need wisdom with this.

Please continue to pray for the sale of our house in Nyíregyháza. We have only had one serious inquirer, and no one has looked at the property for the last 6-7 weeks. It would be helpful to have everything wrapped up there.

It seems like the Lord has been opening up a spiritual door at one of the local high schools here for me to help with English and possibly a Bible study group. One of our Christian friends on the faculty mentioned that many of the young people wanted to talk about Charlie Kirk's death (the events and funeral service were highlighted in the news here in Hungary). We will be speaking with the leadership at the school this week, and we appreciate your prayers for that.

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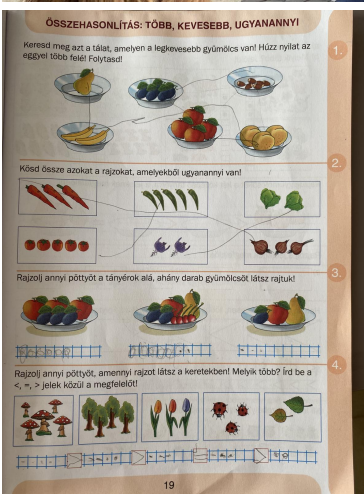
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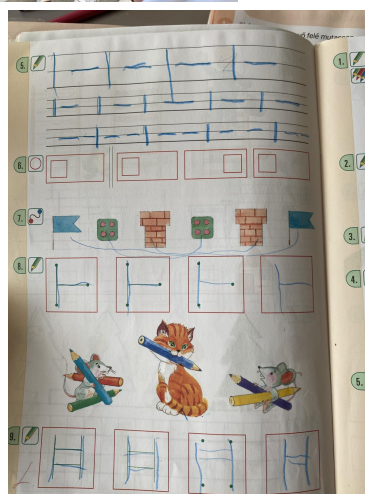
