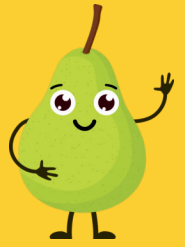

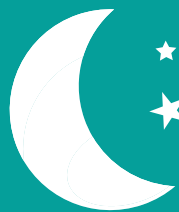

#### Future Plans


- Updates to the school kitchen and cafeteria including a new walk-in freezer and new flooring.


Our goal this year is to raise \$50,000 with 80% of the amount raised going toward upgrades to the school kitchen and cafeteria and the remaining 20% of funds raised going to the Trinity Tuition Assistance Fund. The purpose of this fund is to assist families with funding tuition for their children to be able to attend Trinity. This year alone the Tuition Assistance Fund provided \$48,000 to assist families with tuition.

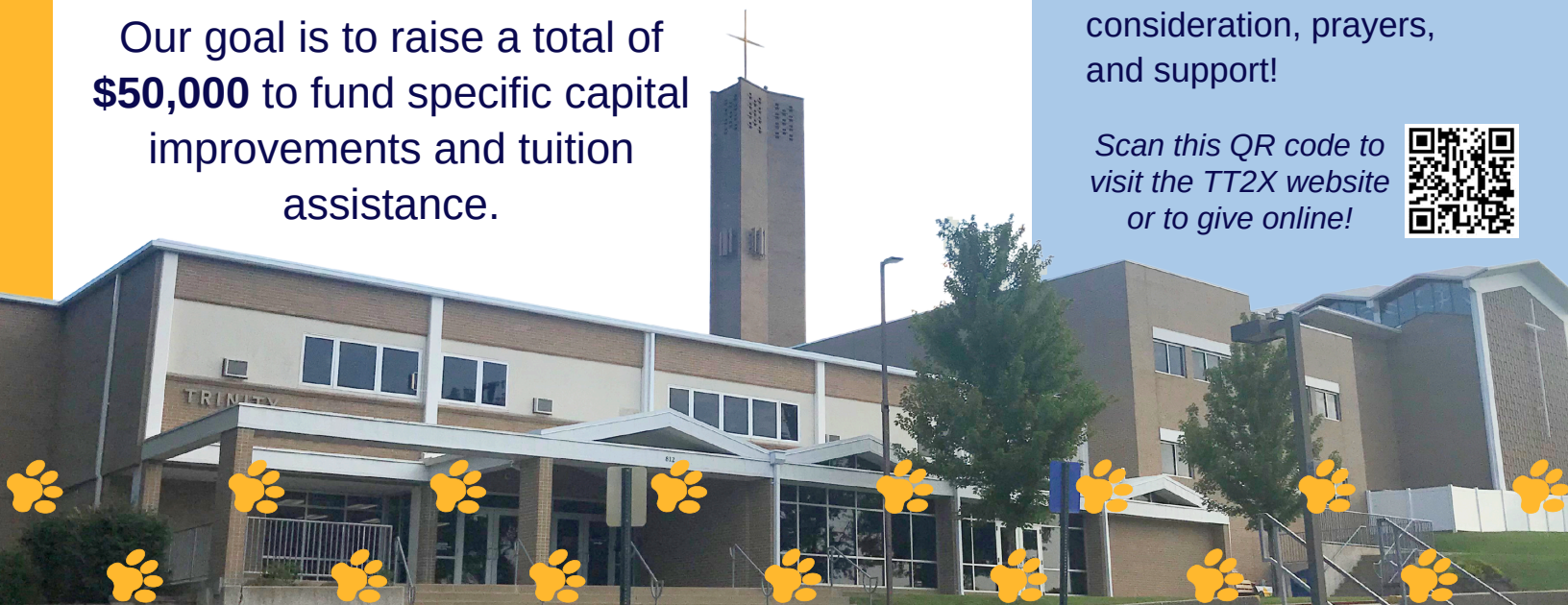

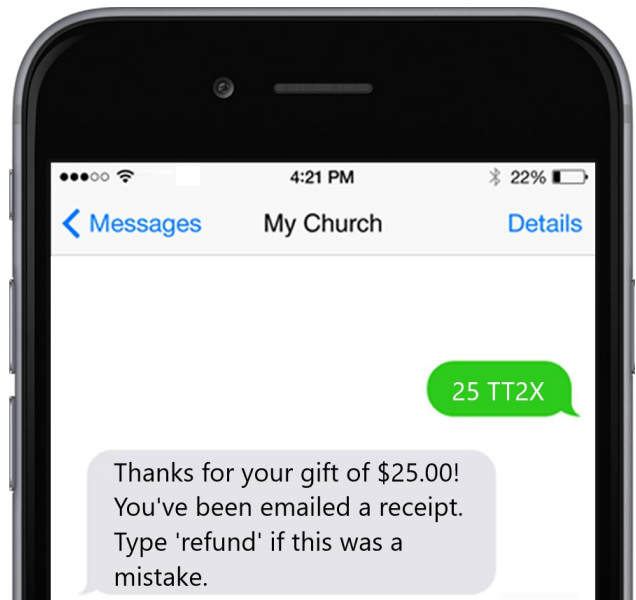
