Think and Thank Philippians 4:4-8

Things to think about:

- Philippians 4:4-7 is set as a paragraph in the NIV followed by Philippians 4:8,9. Discuss how these paragraphs relate to each other.
- Logizomai, translated "think" in Philippians 4:8, can mean "reckon, count, calculate, or impute." Reread (out loud) Philippians 4:8 four times, replacing "think" with each of those four words. How does each different word impact your understanding of what we are meant to do?
- What other Scripture passages offer a similar exhortation and how do they round out our understanding of God's expectations of us in this "thinking" process?
- Read Psalm 8 after rereading Ephesians 3:10-11. Can you answer the Psalmist's question with more clarity, since the mystery of Christ has now been revealed?
- Does anyone in your group have a story of darkness or trial where learning about (being reminded of) God's sovereignty and character, impacted your perspective/emotional state?
