VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY: In our ongoing partnership with Loaves & Fishes, we will be volunteering (rain or shine) to help with curbside food distribution on Tuesday, October 21. To save on limited parking near the food pantry, those planning to help should meet in the church's back parking lot no later than 7:40 a.m. to carpool over. For anyone needing to drive themselves, Loaves & Fishes is at 538 W. Ridgeway St., Warrenton, behind Warren County Health Department. Please park in one of the angled spaces on the right side of the parking lot. Plan to wear comfortable shoes and clothing. We should be finished by 11 a.m. depending on how many clients come through.

COOKIE DELIVERIES: We'll be conducting our Cookies for Schools project on Tuesday, October 28, delivering boxes of homemade cookies to all schools in the Warren County Schools district and other public agencies as long as boxes are available. Those wishing to participate, please bring your favorite homemade cookies to the church fellowship hall by 9 a.m. that morning and plan to stay to help box them up for delivery. Arranging the cookies in boxes (provided) takes about an hour or so, then we will disperse for delivery across the county. The last time we conducted this project, we had more than 1,600 cookies and delivered to some 17 schools and other agencies such as law enforcement, town halls, and the health department. MUSIC NOTES: This morning's anthem, Simple Gifts, is a Shaker song written by Elder Joseph Brackett in 1848. The song reflects the Shaker's spiritual beliefs and lifestyle, emphasizing life's simplicity and joy. American composer Aaron Copland used its melody in his score for Martha Graham's ballet, Appalachian Spring, which premiered in 1944. While "turning" is a theme common in Christian theology, the reference to "turning" in the anthem's last two lines are also dance instructions: when the traditional dance is performed, each dancer ends up where they started, "come round right."
