Paul taught the believers in _____ about their freedom in Christ, warning against the tendency to turn back to “a yoke of slavery” or legalism.

The city of Ephesus was well-known for its practice of magic and sorcery. God's miracles, even in their unusual forms, served to demonstrate that His power was superior to these practices.

Trying to draw from the power of the Lord without the presence of the Lord in your heart is crazy.
