What is listening prayer?

But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

Isaiah 40:31

Listening prayer is waiting on the Lord.

Wait- Hebrew. Qava = bind together by twisting

Saul was looking (Gazing intently) at his men,

David was looking (Gazing intently) at **God!**

**Keep silence before me, O islands; and let the people
renew their strength: let them come near; then let them
speak: let us come near together to judgment.**

Isaiah 41:1

What happens in listening prayer?

renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

Isaiah 40:31

- **Strengthened** – exchange your fatigue with the strength of your youth
- **Energized** – leap, soar, rise up, ascend, get back on top
- **Gain Stamina** – not grow weary, not faint
- **See great things**
- **Hear His voice** – direction, guidance
- **Transformed** – into SAME image

How do I Wait upon The Lord?

- 1. Find or create a quiet space**
- 2. Invite the Holy Spirit to speak**
- 3. Be still but focus on His majesty**
- 4. Start small – 5 minutes**
- 5. Bring a notepad**
