- Welcome everyone and open with prayer.

Optional Icebreaker Question:

- **FOLLOW-UP from last week (Ecclesiastes 1+2):** How did practicing gratitude, rest, and joy in small, ordinary moments (*as signs that your life is received from the hand of God*) go?
- What are strengths of intergenerational gatherings? What are weaknesses or difficulties?

Read Deuteronomy 4:9-10 and 6:4-9

- Does anything jump out at you in these passages?
- How well are we passing on the faith to the next generation? In our church's? In our families?

Read Hebrews 10:24-25

- What are practical ways you have experienced Christians spurring one another on towards love and good deeds?
- What gets in the way? Read Galatians 5:25-26.
- What are ways you have experienced intergenerational differences? What were the effects?

Read Ephesians 2:19-21

- Does anything jump out at you in these passages?

Application/Challenge (this week)

- Reach out to someone outside your demographic or age or ethnicity in some way!

Closing Prayer (5 min)
