Tithe.ly

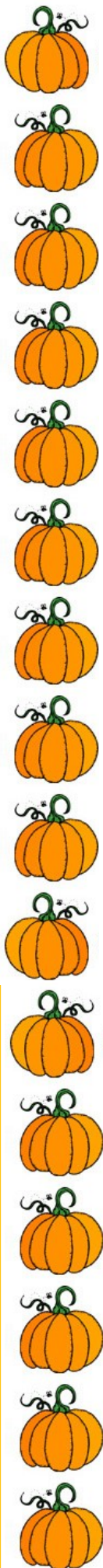
