1 Samuel 30:1-6

As David and his men approached Ziglag, they discovered that the Amalekites had raided it and the Negev. They had burned it to the ground, and the wives and children were gone.

David and the men wept at their loss. The men who were with David wanted to blame him for the atrocity, but David had been with the men the whole time. Sometimes we may find ourselves accused of something when we were nowhere in the vicinity of the incident.

David appealed to God whether he should pursue the Amalekites. He was not about to go ahead of God, however, God gave him the green light and assured him that he would overtake them.

David and 400 men pursued them, because the other 200 men in the company were too weak to continue. David attacked them and recovered everyone and everything that had been taken. They even took plunder from the Amalekites camp.

Men must believe what God has placed in them, for David believed what God had placed in him. If you place your trust in God, you can be assured of the victory. It may come in small increments or on a large scale, but you will win nevertheless. You must stand in the strength wherewith you have been called. Stand strong in the Lord and the power of his might.
